Raw Water Weir Improvements Phase 1

Bids for the construction of the Project will be received at the Cleveland County Water Administration Building located at 439 Casar-Lawndale Road, Lawndale, North Carolina 28090, until 2:00 PM local time on Thursday, February 8, 2024. At that time the Bids received will be publicly opened and read.

The Project includes the following Work:

The Project consists of construction of one new low-head weir, including a moveable crest gate and boulder cascades. The Project will also include stabilization of the stream banks.

Bids are requested for the following Contract: Contract 3.0 – Raw Water Weir Improvements Phase 1

Owner anticipates that the Project's total bid price will be approximately \$8,764,000. The Project has an expected duration of 730 days.
